She has been volunteering **RARS** on the (Reconciliation and Reparation Project) She works for a tolerance and reconciliation service and arranges meetings between young offenders victims. and "I'm a kind peacemaker .Victims are often very angry," says Mandy. "The sessions can help them. For example, people who have had their house burgled are often pleased to find out who did that." "Because I'm a volunteer, the kids are able to trust me more," reflects Mandy. Any support she can offer to these kids makes volunteering a very rewarding experience and gives value to her life.
